This Privacy Policy outlines our strict protocols regarding the collection, use, processing, disclosure, retention, and protection of personal data and corporate information when you visit our Website or engage our premium software engineering and cybersecurity services.

We process data in full compliance with global privacy standards, including United States state-level frameworks and the European Union General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), given our strategic reliance on engineering talent located within Central Europe.

2. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We restrict data collection exclusively to variables necessary for executing professional enterprise B2B communication, optimizing our digital presence, and fulfilling contractual service obligations. We collect information through the following vectors:

- **Voluntary B2B Communications:** When you contact us via email, submit project specifications, or initiate an inquiry, we collect corporate contact details including full name, business email address, corporate telephone number, job title, company name, and any contextual information regarding your software backlog or security requirements.

- **Automated Usage & Technical Data:** When navigating our Website, our servers automatically log metadata required for cybersecurity monitoring and operational performance. This includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser variants, device types, operating systems, referring URLs, pages viewed, and exact timestamps of website interaction.
- **Cookies & Tracking Systems:** We utilize minimal, industry-standard telemetry cookies to preserve website performance and security parameters. You can control cookie preferences directly via your localized web browser settings.

3. LEGAL BASIS AND PURPOSES OF DATA PROCESSING

We process personal and corporate information based on the following legitimate legal frameworks:

2. **Legitimate Business Interests:** Processing is necessary to protect our technical infrastructure, defend against cybersecurity risks, optimize website navigation, and manage general B2B corporate relations.

- **Compliance & Cybersecurity Auditing Partners:** Certified third-party auditors (possessing ISO 27001, CISA, and DPO certifications) tasked with verifying the absolute structural integrity of our development networks.
- **Infrastructure Providers:** Secure, enterprise-grade cloud hosting and repository environments operating under strict data protection conventions (e.g., AWS, Google Cloud, GitHub Enterprise).
- **Legal Enforcement:** When required by statutory mandates, the Corporate Transparency Act (CTA), FinCEN directives, or valid federal subpoenas in the State of Wyoming.

5. CROSS-BORDER DATA TRANSFERS

Nexis Prime Inc. enforces Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs) and robust data transmission encryption to guarantee that all cross-border data routing conforms to equivalent protective benchmarks as mandated by European and federal data protection authorities.

6. DATA SECURITY PARAMETERS ("SECURITY BY DESIGN")

In alignment with our core business operations as an AI and cybersecurity-focused enterprise, we utilize comprehensive administrative, physical, and logical security controls. All data interactions on our Website and source code repositories are encrypted via Transport Layer Security (TLS) and AES-256 protocols. Access controls adhere rigidly to the Principle of Least Privilege (PoLP) and necessitate multi-factor authentication (MFA) across all organizational tiers. Our network perimeters are subjected to constant monitoring and manual code reviews to preemptively mitigate OWASP-top-10 risks.

7. DATA RETENTION GUIDELINES

We retain personal and corporate operational records only for the duration required to achieve the explicit processing milestones outlined in this policy, or as mandated by statutory retention periods (such as IRS financial tax records requiring a 7-year history). Upon expiration of the operational or statutory retention period, all associated records are permanently purged or irrevocably anonymized using secure electronic shredding standards.
